## **Regional Shoreline Master Program Update Advisory Committee Essentials**

- The Advisory Committee is being formed by the city and county partners in the Regional Shoreline Master Program (RSMP) update project.
- The committee will be appointed to include a broad range of interests and includes representatives of the community, of the partner agencies and of other governmental agencies. Total membership will be approximately 16 persons.
- The purpose of the committee is to review materials prepared by the joint staff team and make recommendations on the RSMP for adoption by the partners. Meetings will be supported by this joint team.
- The committee will begin initial meetings in the spring of 2006. Meetings to review draft materials will begin autumn 2006 and extend approximately 6 months.
- Meetings will most likely be in the evening, approximately once a month. Meeting locations have not been identified yet and a location “central” to the partner jurisdictions will be sought.
- This project will generate a lot of material for committee members to read in advance of meetings.
- The RSMP is being prepared using existing sources of information, guidelines and resource materials. No new studies or “science” are being created for this effort and committee members will not be asked to conduct independent research.
